Pursuant to the requirements of section 177AE (4)(b) of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) notice is hereby given that Kilkenny County Council proposes to seek approval from An Bord Pleanála for the proposed development, N77 Ballyragget Village to Ballynaslee Road Improvement Scheme.

The proposed development will consist of the N77 Ballyragget Village to Ballynaslee Road Improvement Scheme, north of Ballyragget Village in the townlands of Ballyconra and Ballynaslee in County Kilkenny. The proposed development will consist of the realignment of a 2.44km section of the N77 to remove a bend immediately to the North of the Glanbia plant at Ballyragget. The proposed development will commence circa 250m south of the Glanbia Plant at Ballyragget and extend northwards to tie into the recently completed N77 Ballynaslee Realignment Scheme. The works will consist of 1740m of online realignment and 700m of offline realignment works, with associated drainage, including attenuation pond and swales; fencing; safety barriers; kerb line; signage; and all site development and landscaping works.

A Natura Impact Statement (NIS) has been prepared as part of the application for approval in respect of the proposed development.

An Bord Pleanála may give approval to the application for development with or without conditions or may refuse the application for development.

Submissions and observations may be made to An Bord Pleanála on the proposed development in relation to –

- i. the implication of the proposed development for proper planning and sustainable development in the area concerned,
- ii. the likely effects on the environment of the proposed development, and
- iii. the likely significant effects of the proposed development on a European Site, if carried out.
