

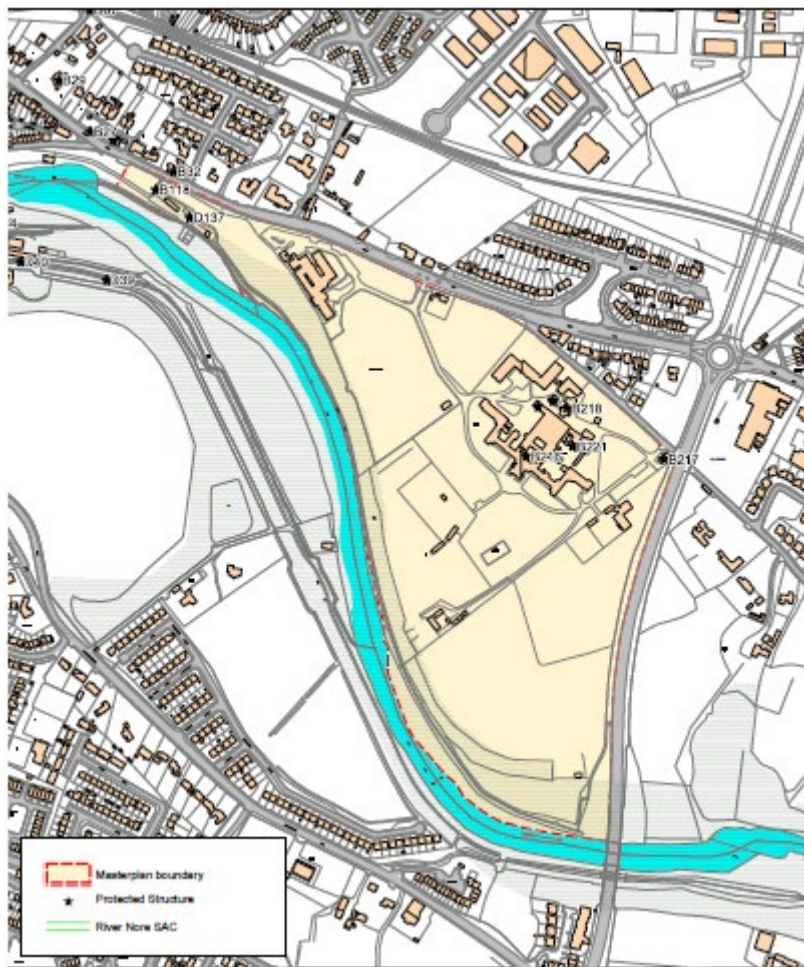

Invitation to participate in & make Submissions to Pre-Draft Public Consultation Phase

Kilkenny County Council (KCC), in conjunction with the Health Service Executive (HSE), is to commence the preparation of a Masterplan, which will provide a framework of detailed planning policies for the future development of the St Canice's Campus (the former St Canice's Hospital) lands at Lacken and Maudlinsland, in Kilkenny City.
