

# Graigenamanagh–Tinnahinch Flood Relief Scheme

## Emerging Preferred Option

The second public consultation event was held at the Hub in August 2022, where emerging options were presented to the public of Graigenamanagh and stakeholders. Following this, an emerging preferred option (Option 3) was identified, and the project team have been working on developing this option. The environmental impact assessment has commenced and is progressing for submission for statutory approval.

The emerging preferred scheme consists of a combination of raised defences (consisting of flood walls and earthen embankments) defences along the River Duiske and Barrow, in combination with the construction of a flood control structure to the storage of flood water approximately 1.5km upstream of Graigenamanagh on the River Duiske.

## Scheme Works Areas

The emerging preferred scheme consists of works in 10 areas in Graigenamanagh and Tinnahinch. Information on the proposed works in each are located on the reference poster numbers on the diagram below.

- Area 1** – Upstream Storage Area
- Area 2** – Well Lane
- Area 3** – Turf Market
- Area 4** – Turf Market to the Hub
- Area 5** – The Boat Club
- Area 6** – Graigenamanagh Quay
- Area 7** – The Dock
- Area 8** – The Hub
- Area 9** – Hotel Street
- Area 10** – Tinnahinch Quay
