Area 5 – The Boat Club

The Boat Club entails the construction of flood defence walls, an embankment and associated works surrounding the boat club on the right bank of the River Barrow. The flood defence wall in front of the Boat Club will be circa 1.5m high above ground level. This wall will include 1m high glazing in front of the clubhouse to retain the views of the river.

The riverward side of the wall will be clad in natural stone. Lift and turn hinged flood gates will be provided to maintain access for vehicles. An area of the carpark will be raised by up to 800mm to provide adequate flood protection whilst maintaining access to the boat storage building.

A flood defence wall will also be constructed along the entrance to the boat club, set back from the existing boundary which is part of the National Heritage Inventory of Ireland.
