DYNAMIC PURCHASING SYSTEM FOR BUILDING CONTRACTORS FOR NON-RESIDENTIAL MINOR BUILDING WORKS

The Local Government Operational Procurement Centre (LGOPC) has published a new Call for Tender (CFT) on www.etenders.gov.ie (eTenders) to establish a Dynamic Purchasing System for **Building Contractors for Non-Residential Minor Building Works** (the DPS).

When established, Public Service Bodies (including local authorities) will run Supplementary Request for Tenders (mini-competitions) with the Economic Operators admitted to the DPS.

To access the DPS tender documents please ensure you register on the Office of Government Procurement (OGP) website www.etenders.gov.ie and search for this tender using the CFT Resource ID number shown in the Table below.

All applications for admittance to the DPS must be completed electronically on www.etenders.gov.ie.

The application process on eTenders will remain open after the Initial Application Period Deadline passes and will continue to remain open to new and previously unsuccessful applications over the period of validity (term) of the DPS.

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ROADS

Kilkenny County Council is in receipt of a request from Iarnród Éireann (IÉ) for the closing of the following roads for the purpose of carrying out maintenance works at Shankill Level Crossing XW055, in the townland of Shankill, Co Kilkenny, on the Dublin to Waterford Line between Kilkenny and Bagenalstown.

Notice is hereby given of the **intention** of Kilkenny County Council to close these roads from:

- **25th April 2025 at 19:30hrs to the 26th April 2025 at 6am and**
- **26th April 2025 at 19:30hrs to the 27th April 2025 at 6am**

- LS6673 from its junction with the LS6674 at Shankill to its junction with the LS6672 at Shankill.

The diversion route for the closure of this road will via the LP 2625, Kellymount and via the LS 6671 and the LS 6672, Shankill.

- LS6674 from its junction with the R448 at Shankill, Paulstown to its junction at Reddy's Cross in Co. Carlow.

The diversion route for the closure of this road will be via the R448 Paulstown to Royal Oak and via Tinnagarney and Reddy's Cross in County Carlow.

The diversion routes will be signposted for the duration of the road closures.

NOTICE OF PROPOSED DEVELOPMENT BY A LOCAL AUTHORITY

In accordance with Part 8, Article 81 of the above Regulations, Kilkenny County Council hereby gives notice of its **intention** to carry out the following works to the Old Health Centre, Kells, Co. Kilkenny R95FV48.

The proposed development will consist of the change of use of the existing single storey Health Centre building into a three-bedroom dwelling. Works include the demolition of an existing shed, the construction of a single storey extension, a proposed new vehicular entrance and all associated site development works.

In accordance with the requirements of Article 120(1)(a) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended) the Planning authority has made a preliminary examination of the nature, size and location of the proposed development. The authority has concluded that there is no real likelihood of significant effects on the environment arising from the proposed development and a determination has been made that an Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) is not required.

As per Article 120(3) of the Planning and Development Regulations 2001 (as amended), where any person considers that the development proposed to be carried out would be likely to have significant effects on the environment, he or she may, at any time before the expiration of 4 weeks beginning on the date of the publication of this notice apply to An Bord Pleanála for a screening determination as to whether the development would be likely to have a significant effect on the environment.
