## Submission: Appropriate Assessment Screening

It is my submission that - the purported NIS is flawed.

In order to determine whether it is necessary to carry out, subsequently, an appropriate assessment of the implications, for a site concerned, of a plan or project, it is not appropriate, at the screening stage, to take account of the measures intended to avoid or reduce the harmful effects of the plan or project on that site.

It is my submission that - Kilkenny County Council should review CJEU case law related to the Habitats Directive and Appropriate Assessment. For example see Case C-404/09, Case C-258/11, Case C-164/17, Case C-323/17 and most recently Case C-461/17 related to the Ring Road in Kilkenny.

"So far as concerns the assessment carried out under Article 6(3) of the Habitats Directive, it should be pointed out that it cannot have lacunae and must contain complete, precise and definitive findings and conclusions capable of removing all reasonable scientific doubt as to the effects of the works proposed on the protected site concerned (see, to this effect, Case C-404/09 *Commission* v *Spain*, paragraph 100 and the case-law cited)."

It is my submission that - Kilkenny County Council should follow the guidelines "Managing Natura 2000 sites The provisions of Article 6 of the 'Habitats' Directive 92/43/EEC" Brussels, 21/11/2018
