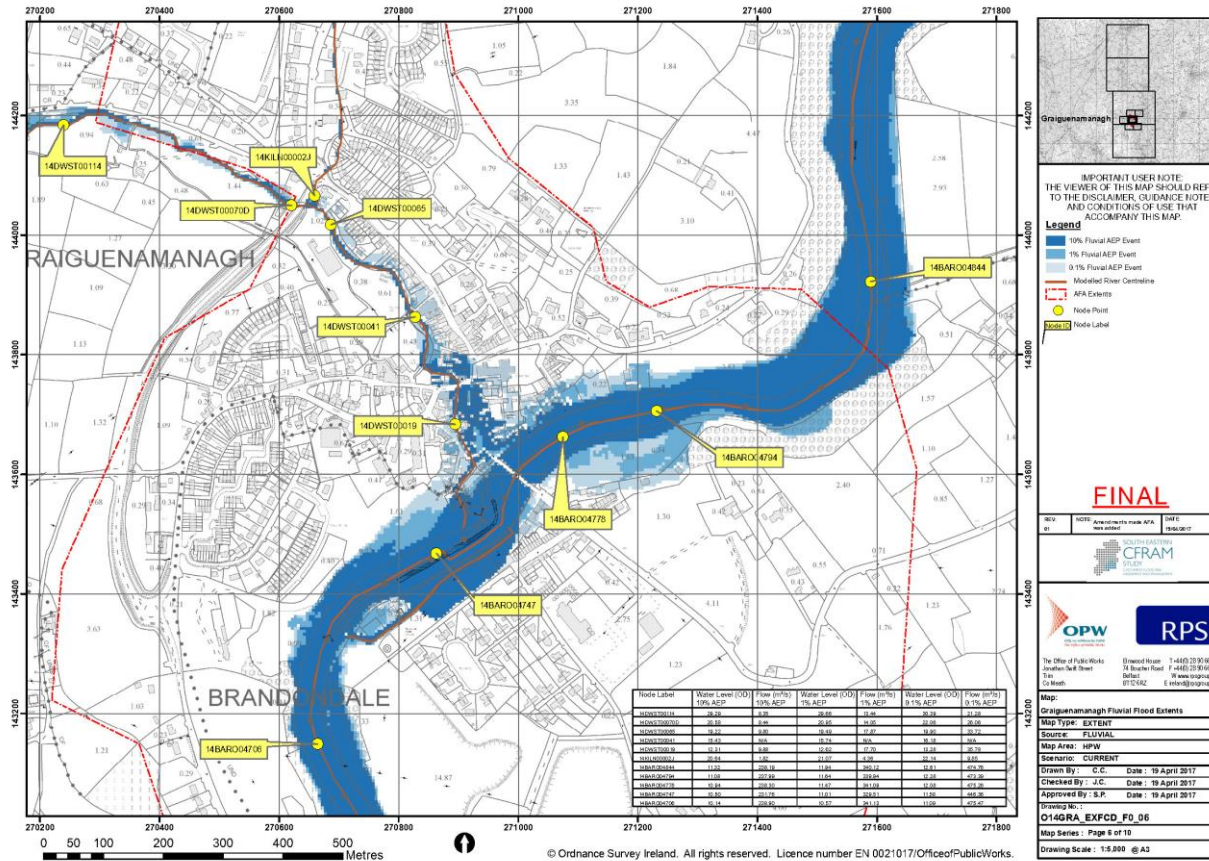

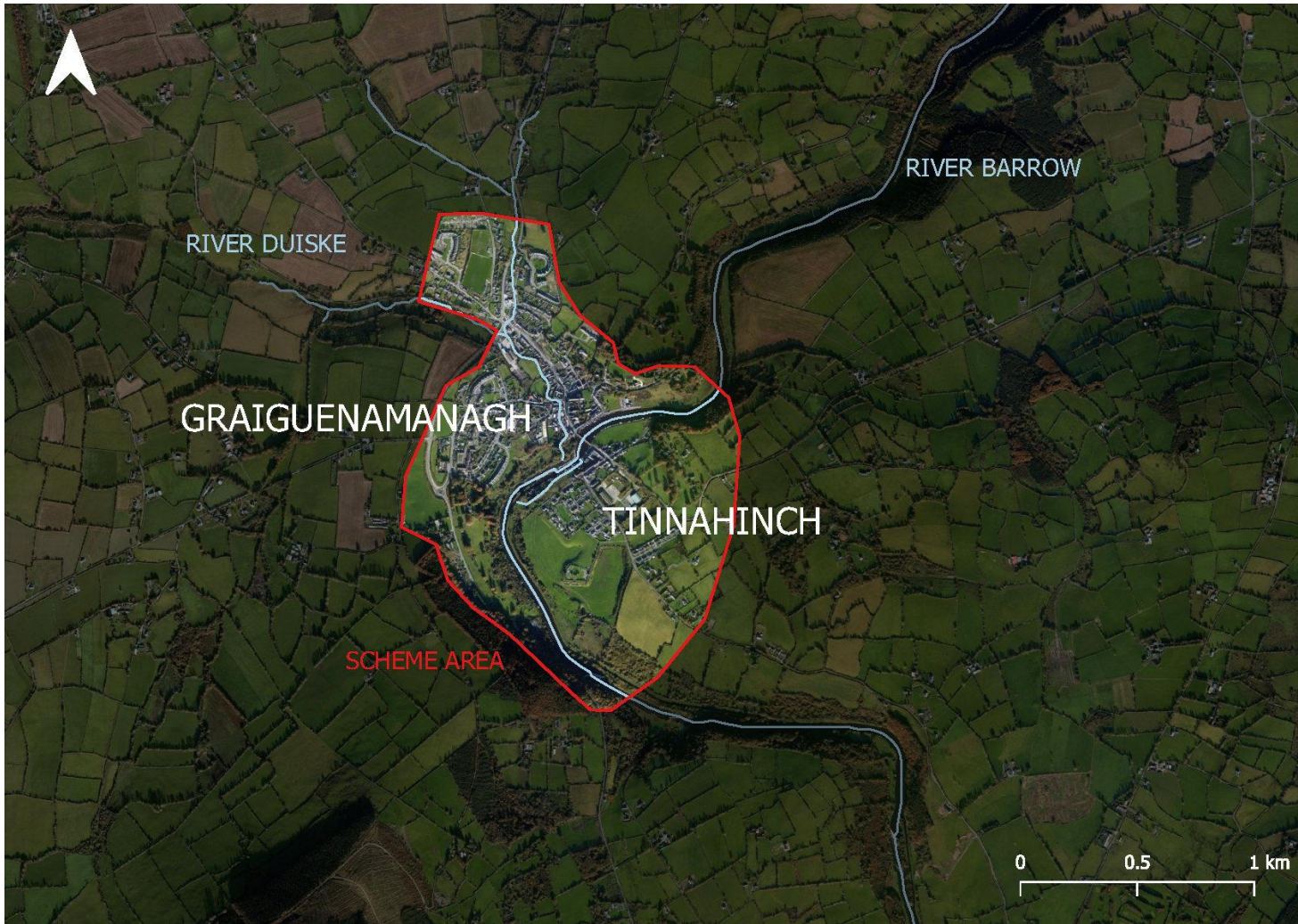


Project Purpose

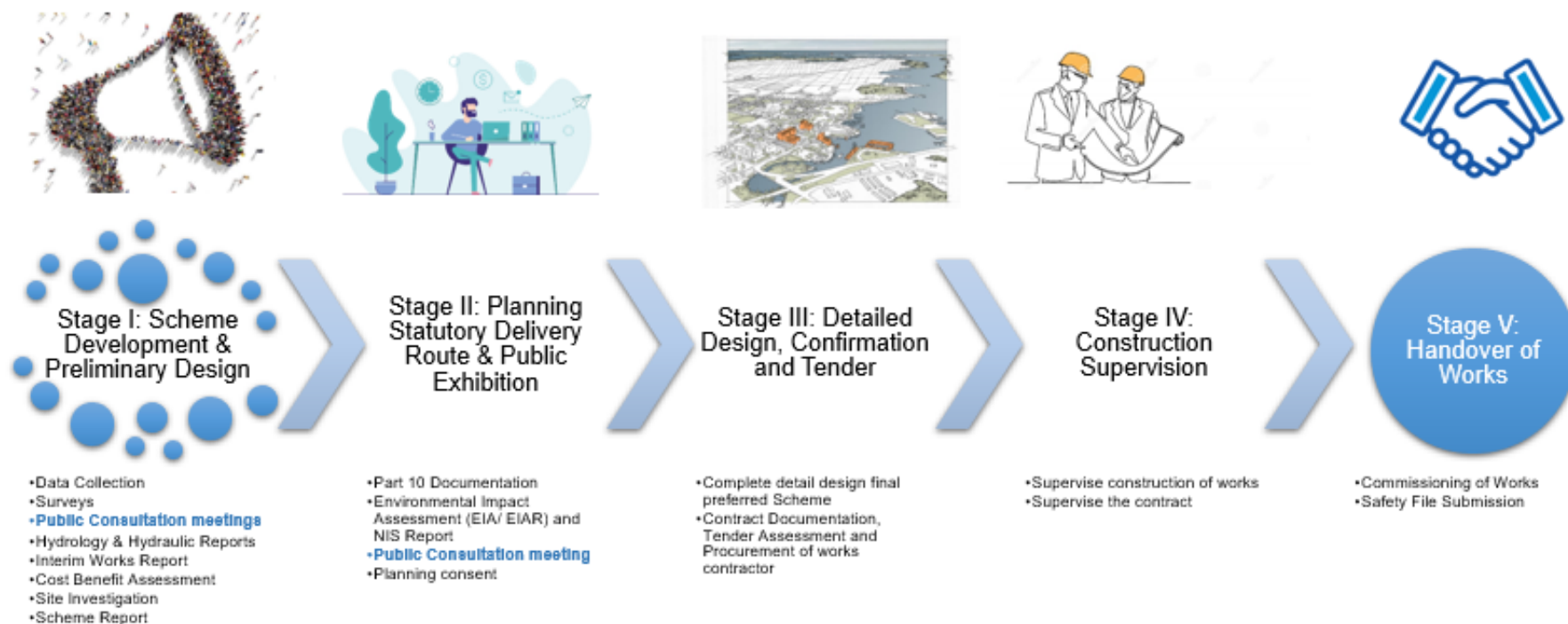
Scheme Area
