Safe Routes to School Programme

This plan contains interventions to improve infrastructure outside and on the routes to school with the aim of increasing the number of children who walk, wheel, cycle or scoot to school.


These proposed interventions are based on survey findings, audits and consultation with Loreto Secondary School and St. Canice's Primary School. The Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Programme launched in March 2021 and was open to all schools in Ireland to apply for active travel funding and delivery. The programme is an initiative of the Department of Transport and supported by the Department of Education. It is operated by the Green-Schools Programme in partnership with the National Transport Authority (NTA) and the local authorities. The interventions described below will be delivered by Kilkenny County Council.







Front of School Improvements


The school zone encompasses front-of-school areas for both Loreto Secondary School and St. Canice's Co-Ed National School to the north. The school zone aims to improve safety and visibility of both schools, calm traffic, and enrich the area through placemaking and planting. Student safety will also be enhanced through pedestrian priority at junctions and improved segregated cycle facilities. Student safety at the rear will also be addressed with the removal of parking opportunities and a crossing to access the bus stop.























